Kit List

(all items must be named)

- Full Uniform
- Waterproof Coat
- Waterproof trousers optional
- Boots
- Trainers
- Jumpers
- T-shirts
- Trousers
- Sock & Underwear
- Sleeping gear / pyjamas / cuddly toy
- Clothes and an extra pair of shoes that can get wet whilst kayaking

- Sleeping bag + Roll Mat
- Sun hat and Sunscreen
- Warm hat
- Wash kit and towel
- Personal first aid kit and Insect Repellant
- Torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- 2 x Tea Towels
- Day Bag (e.g. small rucksack)
- Water Bottle
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Optional book for any quiet periods
