| • Waterproof Coat | • Sun hat and Sunscreen |
| • Waterproof trousers - optional | • Warm hat |
| • Boots | • Wash kit and towel |
| • Trainers | • Personal first aid kit and Insect Repellent |
| • Jumpers | • Torch and spare batteries |
| • T-shirts | • Plastic bag for dirty clothes |
| • Trousers | • 2 x Tea Towels |
| • Sock & Underwear | • Day Bag (e.g. small rucksack) |
| • Sleeping gear / pyjamas / cuddly toy | • Water Bottle |
| • Clothes and an extra pair of shoes that can get wet whilst kayaking | • Toothbrush and Toothpaste |
| | • Optional - book for any quiet periods |
