## Travelling to Camp

• You must arrive to camp in full uniform including shirt, necker and scout trousers, Anyone not arriving to camp in these items will be sent home to get them

### **Packing for Camp**

- Young people are encouraged to pack their own bags so they know what is packed and where it is packed in their bag
- Suitcases are not suitable bags. You must either use a rucksack or holdall

#### **Kit List**

(all items must be named)

- Full Uniform (Arrive in uniform)
- Small amount of spends (max £3)
- Waterproof Coat
- Waterproof trousers optional
- Boots
- Trainers
- Jumpers
- T-shirts
- Trousers
- Sock & Underwear
- Sleeping gear / pyjamas / cuddly toy

- Wash kit and towel
- Sun hat and Sunscreen
- Warm hat
- Sleeping bag
- Personal first aid kit and Insect Repellant
- Torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- 2 x Tea Towels
- Day Bag
- Water Bottle
- Indoor Shoes/Slippers

#### **Other Items**

- Cake for Supper (to be handed in to leaders)
- Explorers must bring a 50-60L rucksack to use during their expedition

#### **Notes**

- The Scout Group cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to any personal effects and the Scout Association does not provide automatic insurance for such items.
- If your child requires medication while on camp please hand it in to a leader in a named container giving full details of medication required
- All equipment and clothing must be clearly marked with the owner's name; engraving or permanent ink are far better than nail varnish or stuck on labels.
- A £3 maximum of spends is recommended. Money may be handed to a designated leader for safety and will be given out as required. The Scout Group is otherwise not responsible for losses.
