Kit List

(all items must be named)

- Full uniform
- Waterproof coat
- Trainers
- Spare jumper, t-shirt, trousers
- Socks & underwear
- Sleeping bag, pillow & roll mat
- Pyjamas (optional cuddly toy)
- If hot sun cream and hat

- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Torch and spare batteries
- Plastic bag for dirty clothes
- Day bag (e.g. small rucksack)
- Water bottle (at least 500ml)
- Book or quiet game
- Optional pocket money (max £10)

- If your child requires medication while on camp please hand it in to a leader in a named container giving full details of medication required
